CatholicCare is constituted as an internal agency of the Catholic Diocese of Broken Bay having no legal status separate from the Catholic Diocese of Broken Bay in its corporate form.</p> <p>All contracts entered into by CatholicCare Diocese of Broken Bay are entered into by the entity known as 'The Trustees of the Roman Catholic Church for the Diocese of Broken Bay' (ABN 79 031 652 544), which is the Diocese in its corporate form, having been established under the provisions Section 5(1) of the Roman Catholic Church Property Trust Act 1936. This entity type has the same characteristics as a company but is not incorporated as a corporations law company. Its legal status is 'other unincorporated entity'.</p>
